## Exhibitions

**Visual Harmonies** is an exhibition which has been curated by The Terryglass Arts Festival for 2011. This exhibition celebrates painting and features four Tipperary based women painters **Josephine Geaney, Judy Hamilton, Joyce Soden and Margaret O'Brien**. While each artist has a strongly distinctive visual style, the process of painting, a focused line of enquiry and a love of texture and colour unpins all of the work much like individual voices within a choir.

### Gerardine Wisdom, Rush Sculptures at Terryglass Quay

Gerardine is a local artist who has won numerous awards for her work including first prizes in the RDS National Crafts Competition 2010 in the 'Contemporary' and 'Rod, Rush & Straw' sections. Gerardine works with rushes she picks from the lake, making sculptures with an aquatic theme.
